District Mill Levy

The current mill levy for the Wheat Ridge Fire Protection District is 7.5. The total ad valorem tax revenue received by the District during 2010 was \$2,343,462.39

The Wheat Ridge Fire Protection District held an election for District Board Directors in May of 2010. There were three available positions and four candidates submitted the necessary paperwork to run for these positions. The new directors were elected by majority vote and took office at the regular District Board meeting on May 19, 2010. Dr. DeRose, Mr. Johnson, and Mr. Putnik will serve four-year terms
